

Teaching Personal Finance
UCO Summer Course – 2011
Housing Information



Thanks to a generous grant from the Wal Mart Foundation, the Oklahoma Council on Economic Education (OCEE) has funding to help offset the costs of lodging for teachers attending the 2011 *Teaching Personal Finance* summer course. Each Oklahoma teacher enrolled in this course and traveling more than 65 miles one way, is eligible to receive a \$150 stipend to help with the costs for lodging from Sunday night, June 19 to Wednesday night, June 22 and Sunday night, June 26 to Wednesday night, June 29. The \$150 stipend is for the entire 2-week course (not per week).

OCEE has secured individual rooms for teachers enrolled in this course at Central Plaza on the UCO campus. The cost for teachers/class participants to stay in a private room during the above stated dates is **\$35 per night, plus an additional \$11** for linens (two sets; one clean set for each week). Total cost for the two-week period (eight nights) is \$291; \$141 for teachers qualifying for the \$150 travel stipend. If this option is reserved, OCEE will pay Central Plaza directly and the total, less the \$150 lodging stipend, will be deducted from the scholarship paid to qualified participants at the end of the course. Central Plaza is a student housing facility but no students will be residing there during the summer months. Email reservations **must be made through drussell15@uco.edu no later than June 15.**

Central Plaza reservations include:

- Individual room with private bathroom
- Windows
- Individual heat/air control
- Queen size bed
- Free on-site laundry services
- Wireless Internet
- Free parking anywhere on campus
- Access to food services on campus
- Secure building with key / code access only
- *Linens packets include: two sheets, one hand towel, one bath towel, one washcloth, one pillow, one pillow case and one blanket.
* If you prefer, you may bring your own linens and forgo the additional \$11 charge.

There are many other hotels/motels near the UCO campus. You are welcome to make your own reservations at any lodging facility of your choice. The stipend is a maximum of \$150 for the two-week period regardless of which type of lodging is selected and reimbursements require a valid receipt from the lodging facility. Lodging expenses acquired by qualifying participants that are less than \$150 will be reimbursed based on actual room rental expense only.
