What is the MEE Competition?

The MEE (Meaningful Economics and Entrepreneurship) Competition is a program designed to recognize student achievement in acquiring and applying knowledge in economics, entrepreneurship, and personal finance.

Who are the competitors?

Students in Grades 3rd, 4th and 5th come in four-member teams from schools all over the metro and surrounding counties.

How does the MEE Competition work?

Each team participates in 3 events. The events are:

- **PRODUCTION:** Each team assembles products in a given amount of time and then are judged on the quality and quantity produced.
- **TEST:** Each team takes a written test on basic economic, personal finance, and entrepreneurship concepts.
- **PROBLEM SOLVING:** Each team designs a product to solve a given problem, creates an advertising campaign, and makes a two-minute presentation before a panel of judges.

What will volunteers do?

Volunteers are needed to serve as team mentors/coaches to assist students throughout the day with the competition events. You will be assigned a specific team of four students that you will get to know and serve as their supporter throughout the day. Please know that a team of students will be counting on you so if your plans change after signing up, please let us know ASAP. Requirements to serve as a team coach: All you need is a desire to help kids! No experience or extensive knowledge is required! A volunteer agreement will need to be signed prior to volunteering.
